During the festival day details about your local futsal club will be available in the clubhouse. There will be videos of recent games and current players and the coach will be on hand to talk about their futsal experiences.

Leeds Futsal Club are West Yorkshire's only National League futsal club. They ended their league season on 15th May with a 15 – 3 away win over Liverpool Futsal Club.

This left the club fourth in the Northern National Futsal League. The team features a number of nationalities who live in and around Leeds. At the time of writing the club are preparing for the Futsal FA Cup in Birmingham.



The progress of the club has been helped by the coaching skills of ex-professional futsal player Junior Roberti who joined in 2009.

The team has a very good team spirit with players born in Italy, England, Portugal, Brazil and Bosnia all being proud to play under the Leeds Futsal Club banner.
